#### **Key Learning Platforms:**

**Flipgrid:** This platform will be used to deliver learning videos and learning tasks. Students will need a code to access the content, this will be provided to you in your Remote Learning Pack. When in the platform, you will see a list of topics that you can view, these topics will be labelled with the learning task that your child will be required to view and/or complete for the week.

**Seesaw:** (Kindy Only) Is a digital portfolio that displays student work. Please upload tasks when directed to by the classroom teacher. Families have previously had access to the Family version of the app to view the portfolio. Parents are asked to download the Class version of the app to upload activities.

**Teams:** Teachers will schedule regular 1-1 and small group meetings with your child. You will be provided a timetable of your child's regular meeting schedule. This schedule will be communicated to you by April 20<sup>th.</sup>

### **Year 1-6**

#### **Key Learning Platforms:**

**Teams (Microsoft):** is the primary communication and collaboration tool between the teachers and the students and also enables communication between students.

- Teachers will schedule regular small group video conference sessions and 1-1 video conference sessions with your child to support their learning. You can view these session times in your child's Team calendar and session times will be emailed to parents one week before school resumes.
- Please use the App rather than the online version- it performs better (unless you are experiencing syncing issues)
- Will be organised into a "General Channel" used for to facilitate learning and a "Social Channel" to allow students to socialise between 2-4pm each weekday only.
- It is essential that you initially access Class Notebook in Teams, so that you then are automatically able to access this learning content in OneNote. OneNote is preferred to Class Notebook because it performs better. You will find this link along the top menu bar once in the General Channel.

One Note (Microsoft): stores the learning content, tasks and instructions for students and parents. All learning for students, in all year levels (Yr 1-6) is organised the same way:

#### **Content Library Folders**

- Student Information- providing information directly to students
- Parent Information- providing information to parents to support student learning
- Weekly Timetable- this is the starting point for each student at the beginning of each
  week. It outlines the learning activities for the week and will help students to navigate
  and plan their learning. This will be ready to go by 9am at the start of each week.
- Physical Education- Ideas and activities to keep fit and active

#### **Individual Student Folders:**

Pages for weekly work will be able to be viewed once the folder has been clicked.

- Spelling- providing a link to an instructional video explaining the weekly learning and tasks.
- Grammar- providing a link to an instructional video explaining the weekly learning and tasks.
- Maths- providing a link to an instructional video explaining the weekly learning and tasks.
- Reading- providing a link to an instructional video explaining the weekly learning and tasks.
- Writing- providing a link to an instructional video explaining the weekly learning and tasks.
